Individual rooms at Lake Morey Resort have been reserved at the discounted rate of \$135 plus tax (single or double occupancy) for the night of **June 4**. Directions:

The Resort is located one mile from the Connecticut River which bisects Vermont and New Hampshire is one of the area's most easily accessible resorts. By car, Lake Morey Resort is a two-and-a-half hour drive from Boston and Hartford, under three from Montreal, and four-and-a-half from New York. We are conveniently located less than one mile off Interstate 91 and just 15 miles North of Interstate 89. We are also within 30 minutes of the Lebanon Regional Airport (LEB), and one-and-a-half hours from Burlington (BVT) and Manchester (MHT) International Airports.

From Burlington and points North: Take I-89 South to Exit 7 (Berlin/Barre). Take Route 302 East through Barre to Orange. Take Route 25 South to Bradford. Take I-91 South to Exit 15. Turn right off the exit ramp. Follow directions from Exit 15 below:

From Brattleboro and points South: Take I-91 North to Exit 15. Turn left off the exit ramp. Follow directions from Exit 15 below:

From Concord and points South: Take Route 89 North to I-91 North. Take I-91 North to Exit 15. Turn left off the exit ramp. Follow directions from Exit 15 below:

From Littleton and points North: Take Route 302 West to I-91. Take I-91 South to Exit 15. Turn right off the exit ramp. Follow directions from Exit 15 below:

From Exit 15: Take next right (granite Lake Morey Resort sign on corner). Follow the golf course (on left) and take your first left onto Clubhouse Rd. Resort is on the right.
