

Bi-State Member Community Health Centers and Clinics Provide Care to 1 in 12 People in New Hampshire



Bi-State New Hampshire Members Include:

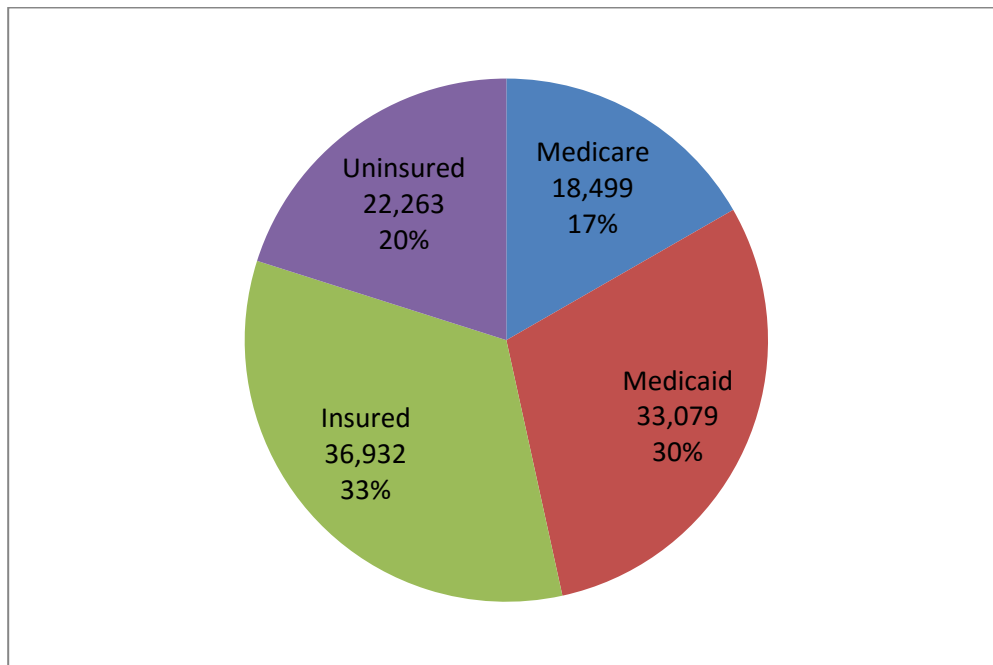
- 12 Federally Qualified Health Centers (28 clinical sites; including 2 mobile vans)
- 1 Non-FQHC Community Health Center
- 1 Rural Health Clinic (4 clinical sites)
- Planned Parenthood of Northern New England (6 clinical sites)

The Community Health Centers serve as a medical home for more than 110,000 patients who made more than 430,000 visits in 2014.¹ This includes:

21% of NH Medicaid enrollees²

23% of NH's uninsured
