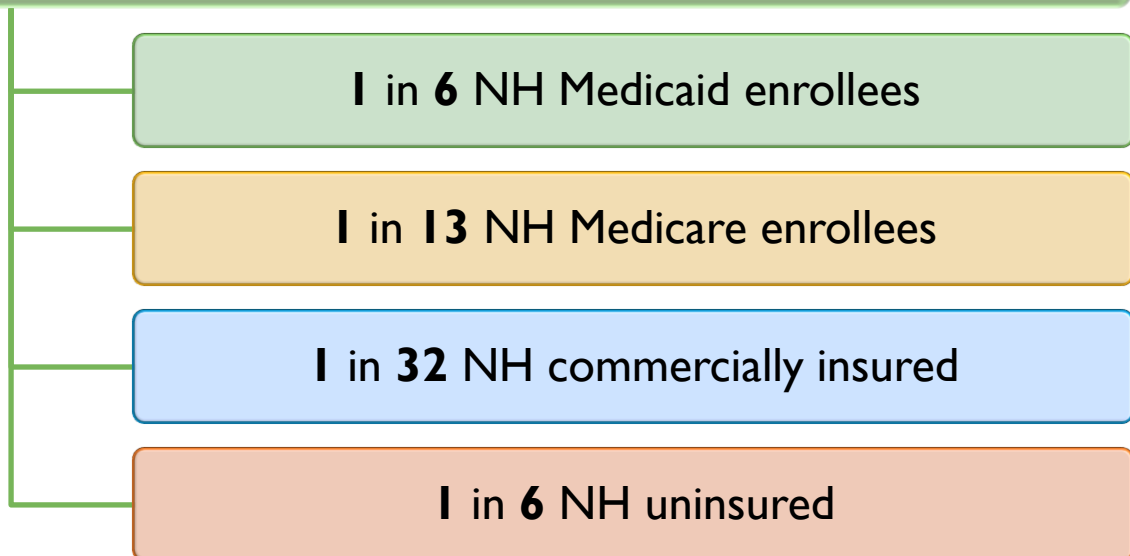


Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) Ensure Access to Health Care in their Communities

FQHCs offer services to all residents in their service areas, accept all types of insurance coverage, and offer a sliding fee based on income for the uninsured.

In many communities, FQHCs are the only provider open to new patients without restrictions, which is especially important for Medicaid patients and the uninsured.

NH FQHCs provide care to 1 in 16 NH Residents,¹ including more than:
