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NH COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS EARN HIGH SCORES FOR QUALITY

NEW HAMPSHIRE – August 28, 2015 – All of the New Hampshire Community Health Centers received awards and national recognition from the Human Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) this week for high scores on measures indicative of quality health care services. The majority of New Hampshire health centers were in the top five percent of health centers nationwide recognized as “Health Center Quality Leaders.”

New Hampshire health centers provide primary care to more than 100,000 people statewide at 39 clinical sites, in-school clinics, and with medical, behavioral health, substance use-disorder services and dental mobile care vans. “We’re very pleased Community Health Centers have been recognized for their impressive accomplishments,” said Tess Stack Kuenning, president and CEO of Bi-State Primary Care Association. “We appreciate the bipartisan Congressional support that makes it possible for them to improve and expand access to health care, especially in underserved areas.”

HRSA awards measure the quality of care, access to care, and value of care from data reported by all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and seven U.S. Territories. New Hampshire Health Centers received awards in six categories: 1) Health Center Quality Leaders; 2) Clinical Quality Improvers; 3) National Quality Leaders, 4) Electronic Health Record Reporters, 5) High Value, and 6) Access Enhancers.
